"What do you think Smithers?"

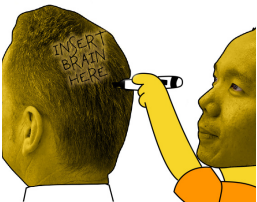
"Permission to speak frankly, sir?"

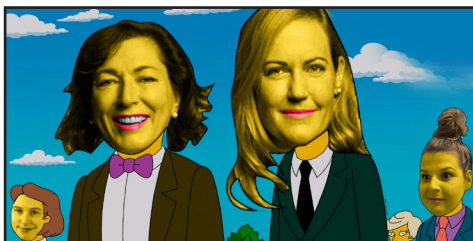

Drew then joined Gundersen Briggs Chartered Accountants as a Partner.

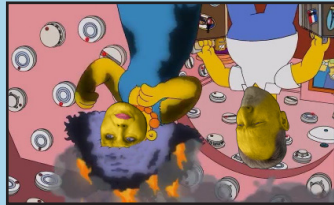
Drew is forever thankful to Homer and the family.
